Application Opened: Monday, October 2, 2023 - 8:00a. (Pacific Time)

Application Closes: Friday, March 15, 2024 - 5:00p. (Pacific Time)

One thing to note: consideration of additional points will be possibly given for students who have a AA/AS or higher degree. Erica and I checked with Financial Aid, and Rachel said she would inform her team that some students might need to "graduate early" to get that AA/AS degree while staying in the high-unit major. She said this information would be taken into consideration when the student does the extension request with Financial Aid.

Also please note: Official Transcript(s) must be evaluated by Santa Rosa Junior College's Admissions & Records office prior to submission. Students who have done all of their prereqs at other colleges will not have their transcripts evaluated unless we advocate for that on their behalf. Amanda G has reached out to RT and Eval to bring this to their attention. Will update once I hear back.

#### Nursing

Applications for the Fall 24/Spring 25 cohorts will be accepted beginning October 2, 2023 through 5:00pm February 7, 2024.

The Application is now posted on the web. It is listed at the very bottom of the Getting Started page: https://adn.santarosa.edu/getting-started

Important information to note about changes with the TEAS: If TEAS has been taken, an unofficial copy of the first TEAS test taken should be submitted with this application.

For this 2024-2025 application cycle, the earliest score they will accept is the first TEAS taken after October 2, 2022. There must be 6 months between TEAS testing taken to remediate scores below 62%.

Students who do not submit a TEAS score with their application but qualify for the lottery and are selected for provisional admission MUST submit a copy of their official TEAS score with their Provisional Admissions Acceptance form by the acceptance deadline stated in the provisional Admissions Packet. SRJC will no longer be administering the TEAS for admitted lottery applicants.

## Dental Hygiene

Application is now LIVE as of October 2, 2023, 8 am - and will close on January 26, 2024, 5 pm

A complete application must include the following:

- Completed Dental Hygiene Program Online Application submitted by 5 pm, January 26, 2024. Students will not be able to access the online application after January 26, 2024, 5 p.m.
- Unofficial SRJC transcript, if any prerequisites completed at SRJC. These should be PDF's or documents not screen shots. Screenshots of transcripts or partial images of transcripts will not be accepted. Encourage the student to go back and make sure to double check their uploaded transcripts to ensure they are attaching a full and complete transcript. They do not need to order an official copy of your SRJC transcript to be sent to Admissions & Records.

## And/or

3. Official transcripts from any Institutions other than SRJC where prerequisites were completed need to be sent to Admissions & Records. Transcripts must be received by SRJC Admissions & Records ONLY by February 2, 2024. Do not upload these transcripts to the application.

Applications that do not have all transcripts on file with Admissions & Records by Feb 2, will not be processed.

Applications missing any of the above will be considered incomplete and will not be eligible for lottery; no exceptions. You will not be contacted if items are missing or incomplete so we encourage you to plan ahead, meet with a counselor and read though the instructions carefully.
